



**THE BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

**(Hogshaw Road, North Marston)**

**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER, 2017**

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order, which will temporarily prohibit any vehicle from proceeding, except for access, in that length of Hogshaw Road, North Marston, for 70 meters.

The alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure will be via Hogshaw Road, Quainton Road, High Street, Portway, Marston Hill, Bowling Alley, Baulk Road, Pitchcott Road, Pitchcott Hill, Carters Lane and vice versa.

The closure is required whilst Cadent Gas works take place and it is anticipated that the works will commence on 17 July 2017 and will take approximately 20 days to complete.

The Order will come into operation on 17 July 2017 when the appropriate signs are lawfully displayed and will continue for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the said works have been completed whichever is the earlier.

Penalties for not observing these restrictions will be as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.
