## North Marston Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group Results of Open House Event 1 held on 7<sup>th</sup> July 2018

## **Outline Methodology**

- Attendees at the Open House event were asked to respond to 3 questions:
  - o What do you like most about living here?
  - o What are your biggest concerns now and in the future?
  - o what progress and changes would you like to see in the future?
- Attendees were asked to write responses on adhesive notes that were colour-coded according to area of residence.
- Then to affix their responses to a board within board-space associated with their perceived degree of importance (most important; important; less important)
- Responses were recorded on Excel Spreadsheet as follows:
  - Question
  - o Area of residence colour code
  - Response (exact)
  - o Responder's assigned degree of importance (most; important; less)
- Analysis: trend keywords were extracted by the analysts (TJ and ML) from the responses where there was direct or indirect association with the keyword and these recorded
- Numbers of trend keywords were summed and the charts show descending order of sums of occurrence

## Results

- 221 response notes were received
- · Greatest attendance was by residents from "blue"
