
North Marston Community Speedwatch Group (NMCSWG): MVAS Vehicle Speed Report March 2019: Recorded at The Pilgrim (facing Portway) 4th March to 1st April 2019 (28 days)

The MVAS (Moveable Vehicle Activated Sign) device is pole-mounted at variable points in the village. MVAS logs data on vehicles' speed, date and time coming into the village and flashes up a speed limit reminder to violators moving faster than 30mph, the legal speed limit in North Marston.

Results

- The Pilgrim is located at, approximately, the centre of the village on the main highway near a junction and a bend in the road with limited visibility
- 23865 vehicle passes were recorded over 28 days.
- 5% of vehicles were recorded as travelling at speeds greater than the speed limit of 30mph
- 11 vehicles were recorded travelling at speeds of 40-45, and 1 at 45-50mph
- Driving at or above 40mph round a limited-visibility bend in the centre of the village increases risks of injury and death to other drivers, pedestrians, and pets out and about in North Marston, and also increases risks of damage to property.
