
North Marston Community Speedwatch Group (NMCSWG): MVAS Vehicle Speed Report April 2019: Recorded at Quainton Road (incoming towards village centre)

The MVAS (Moveable Vehicle Activated Sign) device is pole-mounted at variable points in the village. MVAS logs data on vehicles' speed, date and time coming into the village and flashes up a speed limit reminder to violators moving faster than 30mph, the legal speed limit in North Marston.

Results

- Technical problems appeared to have occurred with the MVAS device during this recording period
- Only 7285 vehicle passes were recorded during this time period; this figure is far less than would be expected for this location.
- Results indicate that during functional operation, 1132 vehicle passes (16%) violated the 30mph speed limit
- Parts of Quainton Road, before the MVAS location is reached, have no footpath. Speeding increases risks to pedestrians, dog walkers and riders and their horses of injury and death from collision with speeding vehicles.
