
North Marston Community Speedwatch Group (NMCSWG): MVAS Vehicle Speed Report August 2019: Recorded at Granborough Road (going towards Granborough)

The MVAS (Moveable Vehicle Activated Sign) device is pole-mounted at variable points in the village. MVAS logs data on vehicles' speed, date and time coming into the village and flashes up a speed limit reminder to violators travelling faster than 30mph, the legal speed limit in North Marston.

Results

- 20950 vehicle passes were recorded,
- 59% of vehicles (12348) were recorded violating the 30mph speed limit.
- The fastest recorded vehicle (1) was travelling between 75-80mph; 2 at 65-70mph; 16 at 55-60.
- Speeding increases risks of injury and death to pedestrians, dog walkers, cyclists, riders and their horses and residents' pets
