
North Marston Community Speedwatch Group (NMCSWG): MVAS Vehicle Speed Report May 2019: Recorded at Quainton Road (going out from village centre)

The MVAS (Moveable Vehicle Activated Sign) device is pole-mounted at variable points in the village. MVAS logs data on vehicles' speed, date and time coming into the village and flashes up a speed limit reminder to violators travelling faster than 30mph, the legal speed limit in North Marston.

Results

- Only 8166 vehicle passes were recorded, lower than expected; this may be due to overhanging branches near the device.
- 10% (795) of vehicles were recorded violating the 30mph speed limit.
- The fastest recorded vehicle (1) was travelling between 45-50mph; 11 were travelling over 40mph.
- Parts of Quainton Road, past the MVAS location, have no footpath. Speeding increases risks to pedestrians, dog walkers and riders and their horses and residents' pets, of injury and death from collision with speeding vehicles.
