

North Marston Community Speedwatch Group (NMCSWG): Report to North Marston Parish Council Village Meeting May 2019

NMCSW is a volunteer group recognised by, and provides support to, Thames Valley Police (TVP) to monitor speeds of vehicles travelling within North Marston Village.

Two devices are operated:

- **MVAS (Moveable Vehicle Activated Sign):** is a pole-mounted device placed at variable points in the village. MVAS logs data on all vehicles' speed, date and time coming into the village and flashes up a speed limit reminder to violators travelling faster than 30mph, the legal speed limit in North Marston.

Data is downloaded monthly and analysed by NMCSW members and reported to the Parish Council and Parish <magazine and social media for public information

- **Sentinel:** is a device that records images and speeds of vehicles travelling at 36mph or faster. Sentinel is operated by the volunteer group according volunteers' availability and the weather conditions.

Those vehicles' registrations and speeds that violate the 30mph speed limit are reported to TVP for action according to their procedures.

The long-term plan is to record data and seek opportunities to manage excessive speeds by drivers travelling through the village.

NMCSW is seeking additional volunteers' time and are seeking more people to participate.

NMCSW has reported data every month over the last 12 months and before, although December 2018 and January 2019 were combined.
