
## North Marston Community Speedwatch Group (NMCSWG): MVAS Vehicle Speed Report

September 2019: Recorded at Granborough Road (coming into village)

The MVAS (Moveable Vehicle Activated Sign) device is pole-mounted at variable points in the village. MVAS logs data on vehicles' speed, date and time coming into the village and flashes up a speed limit reminder to violators travelling faster than 30mph, the legal speed limit in North Marston.

## Results

- 22416 vehicle passes were recorded,
- 50% of vehicles (11208) were recorded violating the 30mph speed limit.
- The fastest recorded vehicle (1) was travelling between 90-95mph; 1 at 75-80mph; 1 at 65-70mph; 6 at 60-65mph.
- Speeding increases risks of injury and death to pedestrians, dog walkers, cyclists, riders and their horses and residents' pets, and Sportsfield users.
