
North Marston Community Speedwatch Group (NMCSWG): MVAS Vehicle Speed Report

November 2019: Recorded at Quainton Road (going out of village)

The MVAS (Moveable Vehicle Activated Sign) device is pole-mounted at variable points in the village. MVAS logs data on vehicles' speed, date and time coming into the village and flashes up a speed limit reminder to violators travelling faster than 30mph, the legal speed limit in North Marston.

Results

- 20046 vehicle passes were recorded,
- 21% of vehicles (4209) were recorded violating the 30mph speed limit.
- The fastest recorded vehicles (12) were travelling between 45-50 mph;
- There is no footpath beyond Shepperd's Close, increasing risks to safety
- Speeding increases risks of injury and death to pedestrians, dog walkers, cyclists, riders and their horses and residents' pets.
