

WHY IS NORTH MARSTON PRODUCING A NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN?

The North Marston Neighbourhood Plan will enable the whole community to outline a framework to guide the use and development of land throughout the parish

WHAT IS THE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN?

The Neighbourhood Plan is a document produced by the Parish Council to set out the future of our community for the next 15-20 years.

It has legal weight in planning decisions

It forms part of the local development plan

It has to be supported by the community

It gives extra weight to the views of the parish in district council decisions concerning North Marston

WHAT CAN THE PLAN DO?

It can protect local assets

such as important green spaces and local facilities

It can help to direct growth

sometimes by allocating development sites for housing to appropriate locations

It can ensure that new development is sensitively designed
It can act as a statement of improvements and new facilities
wanted by the North Marston community

WHAT CAN'T IT DO?

It can't prevent new development completely

It can't be in direct conflict with Aylesbury Vale's Local Plan

or with Government Planning and Guidance

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE TO PRODUCE THE PLAN?

The production of a Neighbourhood Plan, including an independent legal examination, usually takes between 2 and 4 years.

HOW DOES THE PARISH APPROVE THE PLAN?

A formal parish referendum is held to approve the plan A simple majority of voters is required for approval



We'll be making recommendations for the future in all these areas and more:

The protection of important buildings and historic assets

The protection and development of the existing environment

The retention and development of community facilities

The nature, size, and design of housing development

Provisions for the establishment/expansion of businesses

Transport and access issues

Infrastructure improvements
