


# NORTH MARSTON NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN



As you probably know, North Marston Parish Council is preparing a Neighbourhood Plan covering the whole Parish. Over the past three years, the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group has undertaken initial consultation and gathered background evidence. **It has now completed a draft Neighbourhood Plan and an accompanying draft Design Code.**

In accordance with national regulations, the Draft Neighbourhood Plan has now entered a period of formal consultation which will end on **Wednesday February 9<sup>th</sup>, 2022.**

During the consultation period, it is important that as many members of the North Marston community as possible comment on the draft Plan and the draft Design Code to try and ensure that it does represent the views of the Parish.

The Parish Council is, therefore, encouraging a wide range of residents, local organisations and businesses in the Parish to make their views known.

**As part of this process, your comments are invited.**

**It is hoped that as many consultees as possible will use electronic means to read the plan and submit comments in the interests of efficiency and the environment.**

If circumstances allow, the Steering Group will also be holding two drop-in sessions during the consultation period where all the documents can be viewed and discussed. These will take place on the following dates:

- Saturday January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022, between 10am and 12 noon in the Memorial Hall
- Thursday February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2022, between 7.30pm and 9.30pm in the Wesley Centre

The Steering Group and Parish Council look forward to hearing from you by the close of the consultation.
